Vehicle identification tags are required for admission and are available at theTown Office during business hours. Tags are free.

Fees apply for disposal of the waste categories below. Fees are paid by voucher, available at the Town Office during regular business hours. Vouchers are not available at the Transfer Station. In lieu of vouchers, checks for exact amount made out to the Town of Newbury will be accepted.



Construction & Demolition (C&D)

Includes furniture, insulation, painted wood, painted sheet rock, shingles, tar paper, other building materials. C&D waste must be broken down completely. Strip mattresses and furniture into fabric, springs, and wood. Contractors are encouraged to obtain demo boxes.

\$30 per half or small pick-up FEES:

- \$50 per full-size pick-up
- \$60 per one-ton truck

Loads larger than a one-ton truck cannot be accepted.

White Goods (Appliances)

Stoves, heaters, washers, dryers, dishwashers, microwaves, convection ovens, water heaters etc.

FEE: \$10

AC, Refrigerator/Freezer (doors must be removed)

FEE: \$25 Propane tanks (20 lb.) FEE: \$ 3 No fee for disassembled lawn mowers, gas grills, and similar small items.





Tires (No Rims)

less than 16" FEE: \$ 3 16" & greater **FEE: \$10** Tractor tires cannot be accepted.

Electronics (TVs, Computer components)

There are no fees for disposing of the following materials:



Paper Goods

Collect the following types of paper *together* in a brown paper bag or tie them in a bundle. Keep bagged or bundled for disposal.

Include these materials:

Junk mail, magazines, newspaper, box board, cardboard inserts, telephone books, mixed office & classroom paper, post-it notes, brown bags, fax paper, gift wrapping, non-metallic 6-pack carriers.

Do Not Include:

foil products, blueprint paper, juice boxes, carbon paper, milk or dairy containers, waxed or polycoated boxes.

Cardboard

Please flatten cartons and boxes and place them on the pile inside the Transfer Station.



Cans & Plastic

Aluminum cans (beer & soft drink) should be placed in barrels inside the facility.

Tin cans and plastic marked **#1 (PETE) & #2 (HDPE)** (including milk and water jugs & laundry and detergent bottles) should be placed in the outdoor free-standing container. It is not necessary to separate them from tin cans.

> Batteries Please see attendant.

Glass Place in barrel by crusher.





Leaves

Loose leaves (removed from bags or containers) should be placed on the compost pile. Do not mix with brush or any other type of debris.
