## Fire Station Size Information of Local Area Towns

[The following information was collected by committee member Dan Wolf and reported at the November 17 committee meeting]

**Sunapee** – Built in 2006. Building is 80x80 for trucks and 16X80 for storage. There are 8 bays and the police have an additional 2 bays. All bays are double entry with 5 doors in front and 5 doors in the rear... I met with Chief Ruggles and he is very happy with the station. He says that a ducted exhaust for the trucks was the best thing that they put in. The building was designed by Dennis Mires who can provide further information

**Henniker** – Built in 1996. The fire bay is 60x80 with 4 bays front and 3 to the rear. The office area is 40x60, but on 2 floors. I spoke with Chief Bird and was shown around by Mike, a full time EMT. They have 2 full time members of the ambulance on duty during the day. There are 2 bunk rooms with toilet facilities. They are very happy with the building.

**New London** – Built in 2004. The total area according to Chief Lyon is 5,689 sq. feet. They have 3 main bays and 2 others for equipment and/or Chief's car etc. They have bunk rooms, laundry. The women's room sleeps 4 and the men's room sleeps 8. They would expand the meeting room which is 25 x 31. If they built again they would want 1 more bay on the front.

**Sutton** is an older station and according to Chief Cochran is too tight. **Wilmot** and **Salisbury** are newer, within the last 5-7 years and the design seems to work well. I'm waiting for specific information on these buildings from the Chiefs
